
## Autumn 3 Newsletter – 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019

**Parents' Evening** Families will have received a letter last week inviting parents to book an appointment to meet with class teachers on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> October between 3.30pm and 7.30pm. These appointments can be arranged online through the School Cash Office system, and will be for approximately five minutes duration, shorter than our Spring term consultation. Our main focus this term is to ensure that your children have settled well

and that we have a shared understanding and expectation of the children. If you feel you would like a longer discussion, please speak to the class teacher.

**Influenza Vaccination Programme** The annual vaccination programme for young children is being extended this year to include pupils from Reception to Year 5, and will take place for our school on 13<sup>th</sup> November. Eligible families have received a letter or email about this already, inviting you to give your consent for this online. Please ensure you have completed this consent, as we cannot do it for you, and without consent the vaccination cannot take place.





**Water Bottles** In school we regularly remind our pupils of the importance of drinking water throughout the day. It is important that each child has a clear, named water bottle, and that these are only used for water, unless medical advice has been shared with school. We often find that, while children may express preference for drinks other than water at home, they quickly learn to accept the 'water only' rule at school. Please help us to ensure consistency and a healthy approach with all our pupils.

**Reception and Nursery Closure** We would like to remind parents that Nursery and Reception classes will be closed on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November for the annual Otley Early Years Training Day. Apologies for any inconvenience this will cause.
