Eligible families have received a letter or email about this already, inviting you to give your consent for this online. Please ensure you have completed this consent, as we cannot do it for you, and without consent the vaccination cannot take place.





Hygiene in school We have reached the time of year when illness becomes more prevalent, and we would like to do our best to keep all members of our school community fit and healthy. We will be reminding pupils to ensure that they wash their hands regularly throughout the day, particularly after going to the toilet, and will be encouraging them to use the hand sanitisers before going into the hall at lunch time. We would be grateful if

you could reinforce these messages at home, as we do our best to keep absence due to illness to a minimum. However, please remember than children who have been sick should remain off school for 48 hours after any incidence of illness to avoid passing on infection. Do remember that you should contact school to inform us every day during a child's absence. Please note also that families who arrive late should come in to school via the school office to ensure that their child is registered. Thank you for your help with this.

Children typically bring in medals, certificates and photos which demonstrate achievement and progress, and we offer an open invitation to parents to come and join us on these special occasions.
